Loose wallpaper has a tendency to curl, especially vinyl papers, so the longer you wait to do the repair, the less chance that a little glue and deft finger work will fix it! Case in point... you apply the adhesive, press the wallpaper in place, and merrily go on to redrywall your living room.

For loose edges, start by pulling the wallpaper away from the wall. Continue to pull until you reach the point at which the peeling ends and the rest is still securely attached. Next, take a small paintbrush and apply a thin layer of repair glue to the loose piece's back end.

Looks to me like peeling paint on wood. The only way to fix it is to remove the storm window which should be easy since you can see the screw heads. If it's totally sealed in there between two pieces of glass, you might be out of luck unless you can figure out who the manufacturer of the windows are and contact them for help.

No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores).
